Day 1

Day 2

Integrating Sustainability into Teaching Practices

- Sharing examples of good practice among participants.

Day 3

Building a Responsible and Ethical School Culture

- Promoting empathy, respect, and responsibility in the classroom.
- Encouraging ethical decision-making in everyday school life.
- Designing activities to engage the whole school community.
- Practical workshop: creating a sustainability action plan.

Day 4

Global Citizenship and Student Empowerment

- Raising awareness of global environmental and social challenges.
- Inspiring students to become changemakers and active citizens.
- Project-based learning: engaging students in real-world issues.

Day 5

Collaboration, Reflection, and Future Action

- Developing collaborative projects and partnerships among schools.
- Presenting participants' action plans and receiving feedback.
- Reflection on key learnings and personal development.
