Day 1

Understanding Giftedness and Talent

Day 2

Identification and Assessment of Gifted Learners

- Methods and tools for identifying gifted students.
- The role of observation, testing, and collaboration.
- Recognizing twice-exceptional learners (gifted with special needs).
- Case studies and group analysis.

Day 3

Differentiation and Enrichment Strategies

- Adapting the curriculum for high-ability learners.
- Project-based learning and inquiry-driven activities.
- Encouraging independent research and self-directed learning.
- Workshop: designing enrichment tasks for the classroom.

Day 4

Emotional and Social Aspects of Gifted Learners

- Understanding perfectionism, anxiety, and social isolation.
- Promoting emotional intelligence and peer connection.
- Building supportive relationships and classroom climate.
- Group discussion and sharing good practices.

Day 5

Developing a Gifted Education Plan

- School-wide approaches to gifted education.
- Creating partnerships with families and specialists.
- Designing a personal action plan for gifted education.
- Reflection, feedback, and certification ceremony.
