Day 1

Understanding Inclusion in Language Education

Day 2

Creating Safe and Supportive Learning Environments

- Building trust and belonging in multicultural classrooms.
- Encouraging empathy and collaboration through language activities.
- Addressing stereotypes and bias in materials and interaction.
- Group discussion: real classroom challenges.

Day 3

Differentiation and Adaptation in Language Teaching

- Techniques for adapting content, tasks, and assessments.
- Supporting students with special educational needs or learning difficulties.
- Inclusive use of technology and digital tools.
- Workshop: designing differentiated language tasks.

Day 4

Intercultural Communication and Global Citizenship

- Teaching respect for cultural and linguistic diversity.
- Activities that promote open-mindedness and intercultural dialogue.
- Incorporating students' backgrounds into lessons.
- Collaborative group projects.

Day 5

From Theory to Practice

- Developing an inclusive language teaching plan.
- Sharing best practices and peer feedback.
- Reflection on personal and professional growth.
- Closing session and certification ceremony.
