Day 1

Day 2

Assistive Technologies and Accessibility Tools

- Tools to support reading, writing, and communication.
- Accessibility features in common software and devices.
- Adapting technology for sensory, cognitive, and physical needs.
- Hands-on exploration of assistive apps and platforms.

Day 3

Designing Inclusive Digital Content

- Universal Design for Learning (UDL) principles.
- Creating accessible presentations, documents, and videos.
- Using multimedia to reach multiple learning styles.
- Workshop: designing an inclusive digital lesson.

Day 4

Engaging Students through Digital Collaboration

- Interactive learning platforms for inclusive participation.
- Promoting teamwork and creativity with ICT tools.
- Blended learning models and accessibility.
- Group activity: designing a collaborative digital project.

Day 5

Building Inclusive Digital Classrooms

- Planning and implementing ICT inclusion strategies.
- Involving families and support staff in digital learning.
- Sharing best practices and success stories.
- Reflection, feedback, and certification ceremony.
