- To use assistive technologies and digital tools that facilitate accessibility and participation for all students.
- To foster a classroom culture based on empathy, equity, and mutual respect, promoting positive social interaction and peer inclusion.

- Participants will understand different categories of SEN, their causes, and implications for teaching and learning.
- They will be able to identify early signs of learning or behavioural difficulties and respond with appropriate strategies.
- They will develop practical skills for differentiation, classroom management, and individual support.
- They will create inclusive lesson plans that integrate diverse learning styles and needs.
- They will strengthen their communication and collaboration skills with parents, counsellors, and educational staff.
- They will be equipped to cultivate a supportive, equitable, and inclusive classroom environment where every student can thrive academically and socially.
